

Exhibits must be entered from 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. on Wednesday at Concordia Community Center and **picked up from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday.**

Exhibit tags will be completed during check in, or, for those with large volumes of projects, please contact Becky Haase, 660-422-2234, for tags to complete ahead of time. Class numbers will be based on 4-H Project numbers. All exhibits must be created by an enrolled 4-H member.

All judging of exhibits will be done based on the 4-H Project number and age of the 4-H member. Blue and red ribbons will be awarded on each project. Clover Kids projects are awarded a Green Ribbon. Prize money is awarded based on ribbon awarded and project number. Blue: \$3; Red: \$2; Advanced Blue: \$5; Advanced Red: \$4. Judge's decisions are final.

Every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits, but neither the Fall Festival Committee nor the 4-H Projects Committee will be responsible for loss or damage to 4-H exhibits for any reason.
