

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All exhibits of farm products must be grown by the exhibitor and of the current year's growth, except as listed.
2. All exhibits must be exhibited in containers furnished by the exhibitors.
3. All articles entered must be the property of the exhibitor and must be entered in his or her name.
4. Each superintendent will be careful to affix ribbons denoting premiums after judging takes place. Blue ribbon designates first place; red ribbon for second place. Until after the awards are made, no marks of any kind, except entry tags will be permitted. No person acting as judge shall be allowed to see the entry books, and no person shall act as judge in any case in which he or she is an exhibitor.
5. In the event of tie, the premium will be divided. Premiums will be paid Saturday of the fair.
6. All diligence will be used to insure the safety of exhibited articles and livestock after arrival and arrangement, but the Festival management will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
7. Exhibitor should ascertain from the various superintendents of departments, what time the exhibits, under their charge, will be judged; otherwise, no complaint or protest on the ground that judges overlooked exhibit will be considered.
8. No livestock of any age or class showing clinical evidence of Brucellosis or any other disease will be permitted to enter the show grounds. Any animal showing clinical evidence of disease after entering show grounds may not show, and will be subject to isolation, depending on the nature or seriousness of the disease.
9. All entries are made with the distinct understanding that in no event will the Concordia Fall Festival become responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to any animal or article. All animals entered or shown in parades must be parade broke.
10. Judges shall award premiums only in classes named in premium list and on animals or articles regularly entered.
11. The Concordia Fall Festival, Executive committee, Civic Club or the City of Concordia, will not be responsible to any person, individual, corporation, or association for any loss by fire, theft, damage, or personal injury or group of person, exhibits or exhibitors.
