Rules for all Float Classes(3):

- A. Entry deadline is Wednesday 6 p.m. (see entry details below)
- B. Entries will be subject to applicable fire and safety regulations, and subject to committee approval.
- C. All entries should be floats towed by another vehicle. Floats on truck beds, self-propelled, etc. require committee approval. All motorized vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver.
- D. Parade Lineup: Line up begins at 4 p.m. Report to float check-in table at corner of 5th & S. Orange in the parking lot of St. Paul's Elementary School before pulling into the parade line-up area.
- E. **Float Classes(3)**: (floats must be entered in one of the classes to be eligible for judging/prizes)
 - a. Religious (Open to religious organizations, churches, and parochial schools. Theme must be religious.)
 - b. Decorated (Open to all entries not eligible for Religious or Miniatures)
 - c. Miniatures (Entry in name of individual(s). Float cannot exceed 12 feet.
- F. **Judging**: begins at 5 p.m. and completed prior to start of the parade. Prizes and awards will be awarded prior to start of the parade. Judging criteria is as follows:
 - i. 35% - Theme (how well the float expresses its theme)
 - ii. 35% - Beauty (overall general appearance and eye appeal)
 - iii. 30% - Originality (originality of theme, expression, construction)
- G. **Prize money & ribbons**:
 - a. Prize money & ribbons awarded in each Float class: 1st - \$500, 2nd - \$100, 3rd - \$70, 4th - \$50
 - b. 1 Grand Prize & ribbon (awarded to a Religious or Decorated float based on highest overall all score): Grand - \$500
 - c. 1 Theme Prize & ribbon (awarded to a Religious, Decorated, or Miniature float based on Theme and registered as a theme entry): Theme - \$75
 - d. Fall Festival Fair Board Donation: \$15 donation to float entries not receiving any prizes for Religious Class and Decorated Class entries by non-profit social, educational, or service organizations.

Miscellaneous Entries: entry deadline is Wednesday 6 p.m.

- A. Color Guard: 1st - \$30, 2nd - \$20, 3rd - \$10 (For additional information contact Richard Strobel – 660-463-7893).
- B. Bands:
- C. Motorized vehicles (cars, tractors, etc.): committee chairperson reserves the right to limit number of entries.
- D. Political Entries: Entry fee \$250. Political candidates ride in or on a vehicle (no walking allowed). Family members may accompany them. No political handouts allowed.
