You will be assigned a wooden light pole on Main Street upon registration. Contestants will then design/create a scarecrow and attach it to their assigned pole per the rules below.

Rules:

1. Scarecrows must be at least 4 feet tall and no taller than 6 feet.
2. Mounting of scarecrow to the wooden pole: mount Scarecrow facing the street, Scarecrows must be attached below flagpole bracket or no more than 6 feet from top of the head to the ground.
3. Scarecrows should be constructed to withstand weather conditions
4. Scarecrows are to be set up between August 29 and September 6, 6:00 pm.
5. Judging will be done on Tuesday, September 7.
6. Winners will be announced at the Grandstand prior to the Kid's Parade, Wednesday, September 8.
7. Scarecrows will be on display through September 11.
8. Scarecrows should be removed September 12-19.
9. ORGANIZERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO ENTRIES. Organizers reserve the right to use photographs of the scarecrows for future publicity.
