You will be assigned a pole or location on Main Street upon registration. Contestants will then design/create a scarecrow and attach it to their assigned pole/location per the rules below.

Rules:

- 1. Scarecrows must be at least 4 feet tall and no taller than 8 feet.
- 2. Displaying of scarecrow: mount scarecrow facing the street
 - a. Mounting of scarecrow to assigned pole: scarecrows must be attached to pole so does not interfere with flying of the US flag.
 - b. Assigned locations without a pole: secure firmly to location.
- 3. Scarecrows should be constructed to withstand the weather.
- 4. Name of Business, group, or individual can be displayed with your scarecrow.
- 5. Scarecrows are to be set up between August 23 and September 2, 10 pm.
- 6. Final Judging will be done on Tuesday, September 3, 8 am.
- 7. Winners will be announced at the Grandstand prior to the Kid's Parade, Wednesday, September 4.
- 8. Scarecrows will be on display through September 8.
- 9. Scarecrows should be removed September 9-15.
